What is Population Studies?

Population Studies is a specialized and scarce skill discipline concerned with the:

- Study of human populations, their size, composition & geographical distribution
- Changes in these populations over time & the factors associated with these changes
- Broader nature of social & economic change
- Impact of demographic changes on the natural environment
- Empirical investigation of population processes-their determinants & consequences

Why a Masters in Population?

Population Studies is an essential component of many activities such as:

- Demographic analysis
- Social, economic and health research
- Physical & environmental use planning, administration
- People-centred development planning

Programme Structure and Options

- A 2-year MA (14 modules) if you have a 3-year undergraduate degree
- If you have an Honours degree in the social sciences may undertake a
 1-year coursework degree consisting of six (6) modules.

In both cases, students will also complete a short dissertation based on a research project of their own design.
